Overview of the query

This predefined query allows to extract monthly data on EU, Norway and the United Kingdom’s first sales at seaboard level by selecting the seaboard to be filtered. Seaboards are grouping of places of sales belonging to the same area. The following seaboards have been adopted by EUMOFA:

- Mediterranean
- North Sea
- Black Sea
- Baltic Sea
- Celtic Seas
- Bay of Biscay and Iberian coast
- Outermost regions
- Unspecified (for those countries providing first sale data at national level)

At this [link](#)¹, the correlation of each place of sale to the seaboard they belong to is available.

This query allows to display the amounts of first sales occurred in the period starting from January and up to the most recent month available of the current year (i.e. “Year to date”, or “cumulative period”). The cumulative period of the current year is therefore compared to:

- The same cumulative period of the previous year;

- The same cumulative period of two years before.

The table can be drilled in to a more disaggregated level by both clicking on the underlined elements or on the “Disaggregated Data” icon on the top right of the table. By clicking on the latter the table is shown both by place of sale and Main commercial species (for more details, go to “[Products specifications](#)” [section below](#)).

Clicking on underlined elements, it will be possible to:

- By clicking on one seaboard, a further level of detail is shown broken down by place of sales pertaining to the seaboard selected;
- By clicking on one Commodity group, a further level of detail is shown broken down by those Main commercial species pertaining to the Commodity group selected.

Type of data and sources

Monthly data on “first sales” refer to species sold at an auction centre or sold to registered buyers or to producer organisations, as transmitted to EUMOFA. Data include the sales occurred in **places of sale** located within 20 km from the coastline, recording first sales and as transmitted by the related country to EUMOFA.

At this [link](#)², the following details on data and related sources are available for each country:

- (i) Organization in charge of data transmission
- (ii) Origin of data (e.g. sales notes, price observation, etc.)
- (iii) Frequency (e.g. weekly, monthly, etc.)
- (iv) Time-lag
- (v) Type of data (e.g. volumes and values, or only prices, etc.)
- (vi) Geographical specification
- (vii) Nomenclature used
- (viii) Species monitored

Products specifications

Data on the species sold in each country are disseminated in this query aggregated into the related Main commercial species and Commodity groups. Main commercial species and Commodity groups are **aggregates of different fish species and products**. Unit of measure

Volumes are expressed in Kilograms. They are expressed in net weight for EU countries and the United Kingdom and in live weight equivalent (lwe) for Norway.

Values are expressed in Euro.

Prices are expressed in Euro / Kilogram (without VAT). Specifically for Norway, prices are expressed in Euro/kg of live weight.

Quality assurance

At EUMOFA level, regular checks are performed at two stages:

- Data entry: data not in compliance with completeness, consistency and correctness rules are automatically discarded and stored in a specific table within the Database. Checks performed consist in:
 - o File format check
 - o Existence of codes (against codes registers)
 - o Duplicate records
- Data dissemination: the instances of abnormal data are cross-checked with the contact persons of the sources providing them in order to i) clarify if they actually reflect market phenomena and ii) collect revised data and substituting incorrect figures with the new ones.

Quality checks are performed on a monthly basis on volumes and values/prices available for each combination species⁶/place of sale. Abnormal figures are highlighted taking into account: (i) the yearly average price at local level, (ii) the yearly average price at national level and (iii) possible abnormal variations of volumes. These changes are then cross-checked with national contact points for clarifying and improving (if need be) the related datasets.
